Covid Health Bulletin for the sector

- The ecosystem has been hard hit.
- ❖ During the second quarter of 2020 sales of woven fabrics decreased by 35%, knitted fabrics by 44% and the decline in the clothing industry -37%.
- Manufacture of <u>nonwovens</u> for face masks and medical gowns more resilient.
- Employment: Textile -2,1% and clothing -5,6%.

Impact of crisis on the ecosystem

- Collapse of demand
- Industrial value chains not functioning
- Uncertain prospects of improvement




How Bulgarian Textile and Apparel producers try to survive and what BFA is doing
