- 2008: Beja International Airport inaugurated
- 2010s: Investment in the Évora Aeronautical Industrial Park begins, attracting key players like Embraer and Mecachrome
- 2016: AED Cluster Portugal is established, uniting companies, research institutions, and academia
- 2017: Signature of the Cooperation Protocol for the Development of the Aeronautical Sector in the Alentejo Region
