Introduction

Venetian Cluster is the only productive cluster of cultural and environmental heritage in Italy.

Its main target is to realize national and international projects about **innovation**, **technological transfer**, **internationalisation and training** for the public and private supply chain of the sector of cultural and environmental heritage.

Through its services, Venetian Cluster coordinates in Italy **800** companies and **24** bodies such as Universities, research centres, public bodies and laboratories, institutions, moreover it collaborates with almost **2000** partners in the world.

In these years, Venetian Cluster has realized 90 innovations, policy, research projects for a total budget of more than 50 Million Euro.

Our Mission

Venetian Cluster coordinates and supports multidisciplinary public-private partnerships (PPP), enterprises, professionals, associations, public and private bodies, research institutes and all subjects interested in carrying out and promoting innovation projects, technological transfer and actions for the development of the Italian and international **productive supply chain** for the **conservation**, the **restoration** and the **valorisation** of the **Cultural** and **Environmental Heritage** in Italy and abroad.

Venetian Innovation Cluster for Cultural and Environmental Heritage is formally recognized as a **Regional Innovative Network (Rete Innovativa Regionale - RIR)** by the Regional Government of Veneto Region.

In fact, in 2015 the former cluster was closed, due to a change in the Regional law about clusters and internal strategic decision, while the same managing team founded from new the Venetian Cluster, refreshing its statute and organisation, as well as opening to new members and opportunities.
